

## The Emery Family of Marble Rock.

The family gave its name to Emery School south of Marble Rock. They owned the land which surrounded this school at one time.

The original Emery in Canada was Thomas Emery, a United Empire Loyalist, who was granted land in Charlottetown. On Oct 2, 1798 he married Susannah Salt. Their children were:

William (b 1799), John William (b 1801), James (b 1805), Robert (1807), Barzilla (1809), Levi (1811), Charles (1813), Guy (1815), Walter (July 1, 1817).

James was the father of Lewis Emery who married Sarah Latimer sister of my g. grandmother Elizabeth Latimer Richardson. Lewis and Sarah had children: Elva, Edith, Edna & Eldon. In 1871 Lewis and a George Emery operated a sawmill at Marble Rock.

Levi Emery was married twice; first to Rhoana Legge daughter of Joshua Legge, and his second wife's name was Ladiva.

Walter Emery married Margaret Davis on Nov 25, 1845. Their son Walter Brock Emery (1864-1927) married Catherine T. Dickson (1865-1947)

Walter and Catherine Emery had 3 sons: Donald (1889-1949), Russell Ford (1892-1924) and Donald (1902-1952). Donald married Margaret Edwards (1903-1970). Their daughter Catherine Mills lives in Gananoque.
