A Memorial to be registered, pursuant to  
the Statute in such case made, and  
provided, of an Indenture, made the  
Twenty fifth day of July, in the fifty fifth  
year of the reign of His Majesty, King  
George the Third, by the grace of God, of  
Great Britain, King, Defender of the Faith, and  
in the year of our Lord, One thousand  
eight hundred and fifteen, by and  
between, Loel Beale, of the Township of  
Sandowne, in the District of Colchester  
in the Province of Upper Canada, Governor  
of the one part, and Israel Bowen, of  
Sandowne, in the District and County  
aforesaid, Governor, of the other part,  
Witnesseth, that for and in consideration  
of the sum of Fifty six Pounds Six Shillings  
Good and lawful money of the said  
Province, to the said Loel Beale, in  
hand well and truly paid, by the  
said Israel Bowen, at or before the  
making and delivery of these presents,  
The receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-  
ged, and thereunto and thereon, and  
paid from the same and same parts  
thereof, The said Loel Beale doth by  
these presents, Request, Release, and full  
discharge the said Israel Bowen, his  
heirs, Executors Administrators, and  
assigns, and every of them present,  
and the said Loel Beale, his heirs  
and assigns, and by these presents  
doth grant, bargain, sell, give, and  
confirm, unto the said Israel Bowen  
all that certain tract or parcel of said  
situate, lying, and being, in the Town

ship of Lanesdowne, in the County of Beds, in  
that District of Lutetown, in the Third Province  
before and described, by Lot number  
fifteen, in the third commission of the  
said Township of Lanesdowne, contain-  
ing, six hundred Acres of land, be  
that same, more or less, which said tract  
or parcel of land, is better and found  
-ed, or may be otherwise known as  
follows, that is to say, beginning there  
a post has been planted in front of  
the said commission, at the south east  
angle of the said Lot, there north, one  
hundred and five chains, and twenty  
seven ficks, more or less, to the same  
in road, in the rear of said commission  
there west, thirteen chains to the limit  
between Lots two fifteen and fifteen, there  
south, one hundred and five chains,  
twenty seven ficks, more or less, to a  
post, there east, thirteen chains to the  
place of beginning, as the same is  
described in His Majesty's deed or Patent  
granting the said tract or parcel of land  
unto the said Paul Beale, his heirs and  
assigns forever, to have and to hold, the  
said premises, unto the said Paul  
Beale, his heirs and assigns forever,  
which said indenture, is witnessed by  
Joseph Sandon, and Oliver Sandon, of  
Lanesdowne, in the Province aforesaid,  
Yeoman, and this Memorial thereof,  
his Herchey required to be registered by  
me, Joseph Bowen, the said indenture  
signed, witnessed by hand and seal,  
this twentieth day of August, in the  
year of our Lord, one thousand eight  
hundred and fifteen,
