September, in the year of our Lord, one
thousand eight hundred and thirty,
made between, Isaac Bowen, of the Town-
ship of Chesley, and County of Leeds, and
Province of Upper Canada, of one part, and
John S. Bowen, of the
Township of Sandstone, and County
of Leeds, and Province of Upper Canada,
of the other part, purporting
to be a deed of bargain and sale, whereby
the said Isaac Bowen, for and in con-
sideration of the sum of one hundred
and fifty pounds of lawful money of
Upper Canada, to the parties, be paid,
sold, aliened, transferred, conveyed,
and confirmed, unto the said John
S. Bowen, his heirs and assigns forever,
all and singular, that parcel or tract
of land, situate, lying, and being
the whole of Lot number fifteen, in the
Third concession of Sandstone, in the
County of Leeds, and District of Johnstown
and Province of Upper Canada, afore-
said, which parcel or tract of land is
situated and bounded, or may be other-
wise known as follows, that is to say,
commencing where a post hath been
planted, at the south east angle of the
said lot, thence north, one hundred and
five chains, thence seven links, more
or less, to the allowance of road, in the
year of said concession, thence west, nine
hundred and more or less, to the limit
between Lots number fifteen and fifteen
thence south, one hundred and five

chains, Twenty seven Links, More or Less. to the
 allowance for load, in front of the said
 commission, then last, directed chains, More
 or Less, to the place of beginning, containing
 by admeasurements, and hundred acre
 be the same More or Less. Together with
 all houses, out houses, woods, and waters
 thereon erected, lying, and being, and
 all and singular, the hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises
 in anywise belonging, to have and to
 hold, the same, unto the said John
 S. Bowen, his heirs and assigns, to the
 sole and proper use, benefit, and behoof
 of the said John S. Bowen, his heirs and
 assigns forever. Which said indenture

 yeoman, and this personal deed
 is hereby required to be registered by the
 said John S. Bowen, his Grantor therein

 and forty four,

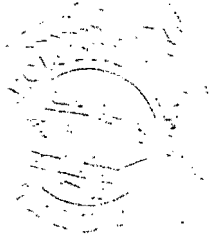
